

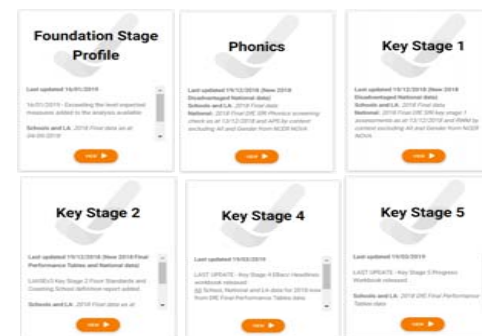
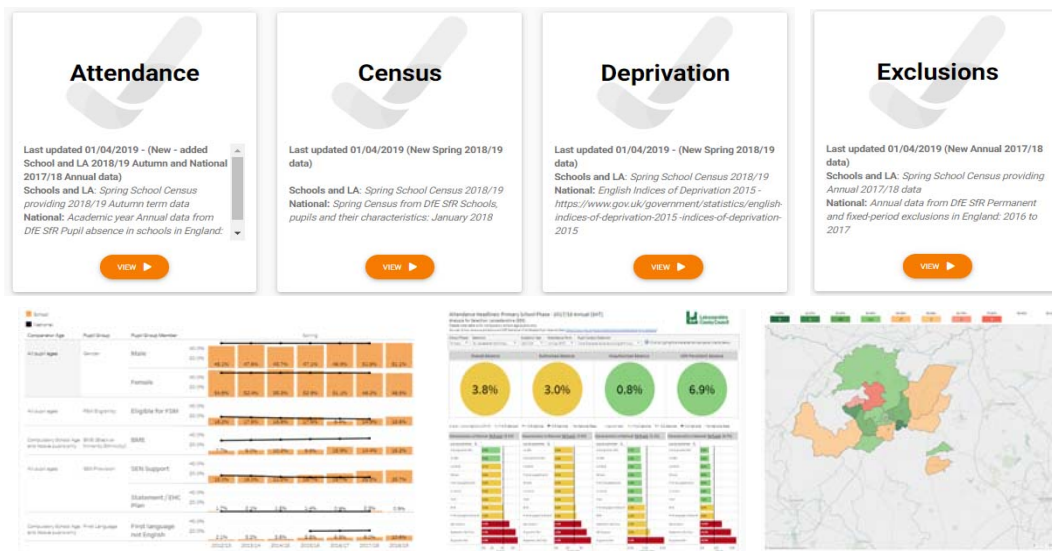

School Census Data in Perspective Lite

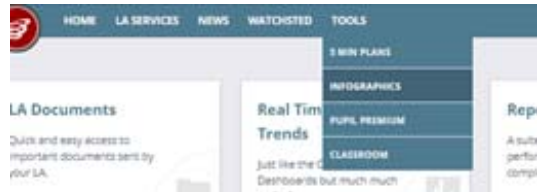
Perspective Lite isn't just one of the ways in which we deliver key stage reports to schools; it also contains some useful tools.



Perspective

One such tool is the **Infographics Tool**. It allows you to load your school census XML file into the system to see a simple yet informative presentation of the data held within your census file.

Below are some simple instructions on how to load your census file into the system.



Log into Perspective Lite.
Click on Infographics in the Tools menu

STEP 1

Search for your .XML file.
Census files can be retrieved from your MIS (e.g. SIMS).

BROWSE

STEP 2

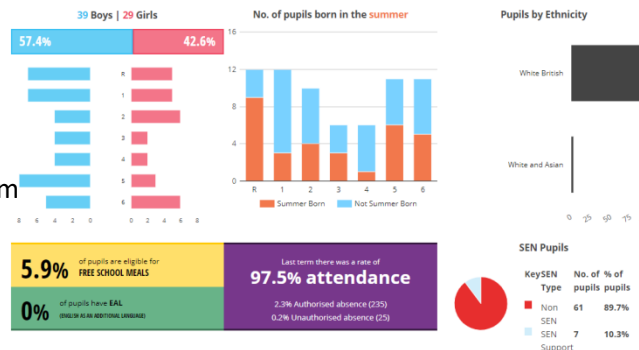
Create your *Infographic*.
Once your file has been uploaded, you can create your infographic.

VISUALISE

Click on Browse and navigate to where your census XML is stored.
Click Visualise.

Data from your census XML file will be displayed. Click on Condense to change the orientation of the charts.

Note – the infographic only displays data from the current collection so does not contain combined term aggregations of attendance data.
